StitchLink II frees you from the disorder of messy and bothersome cables between the computer and your sewing machine.

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Features

Easy to use

Using StitchLink II is like having your sewing machine directly connected over a cable with your PC - with the only difference being that there is no messy or bothersome cable between the two devices. For the following reasons it is simpler and easier to use than a USB memory stick or a memory card with a card reader:

- One-step simplicity you do not have to copy the embroidery pattern data from your PC to a USB storage medium and then transfer it to your sewing machine.
- You do not have to walk from one room to another and then back again to transfer your embroidery patterns to the machine.
- One does not always have USB storage media handy and these devices are easily lost or otherwise misplaced.

Effortless

No need to carry heavy machines around the house - neither the sewing machine to the PC nor the other way round.


What do I need to use the StitchLink II?

To be able to use the StitchLink II you need the following:

- StitchLink II
- Sewing machine with a USB interface
- PC with Windows XP or Windows 2000

If you want to use the StitchLink II in wireless mode, your PC should be enabled for WLAN applications to make use of the 802.11b or 802.11g standard for communications. If your PC is not WLAN-ready you can accomplish this easily either by adding a wireless LAN adapter (USB WLAN stick) or through an Access Point. Your local computer specialist can get this done for you in no time.

You can also connect the StitchLink II over a standard cabled network (LAN).
